CVTS Department

The Department of Cardiovascular and Thoracic surgery at Grant Government Medical College & Sir JJ Group of Hospitals was started way back in 1961 as Thoracic Surgery Department. It functioned as two units, one at JJ Hospital under Dr M.P Mehta and other at St George Hospital under Dr Bilimoria. It earned its first seat as M.S Thoracic Surgery in 1971 under the Bombay University, with the first student being Dr Ashok Cherian. Later on in 1981, the third unit was started under Dr K R Shetty, leading to recognition of three seats for Post graduate training at the Institute.

Amongst the several contributions of the Department to the patient care, some renowned ones include

- The performance of First Complex Pericardial Resection under Cardiopulmonary Bypass in 1964.
- First Total correction of Tetralogy of Fallot in Maharashtra was performed in JJ Hospital by Dr Nimish Shah.
- First Open Heart Surgery under Government Schemes was performed at JJ Hospital. First Open Heart Surgery under Jeevandayee Yojna was done in 1998 by Dr K.N Bhosale.
- First Open Heart Surgery under RGS/ Mahatma Jyotirao Phule Jan Arogya Yojana was performed in 2012 in JJ Hospital by Dr A.R Bhiwapurkar.
