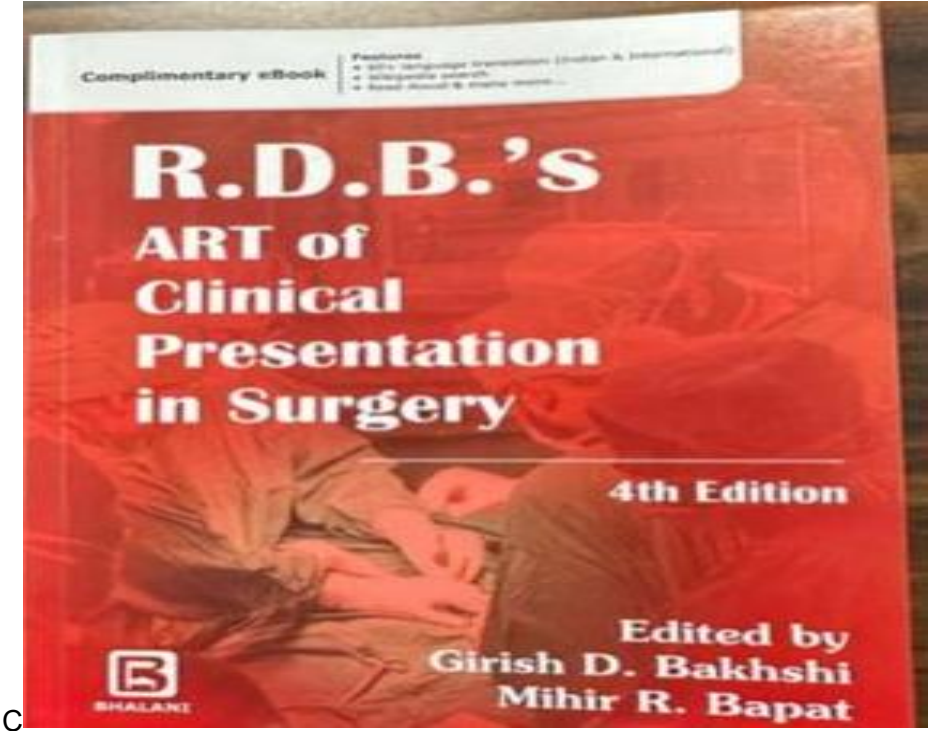

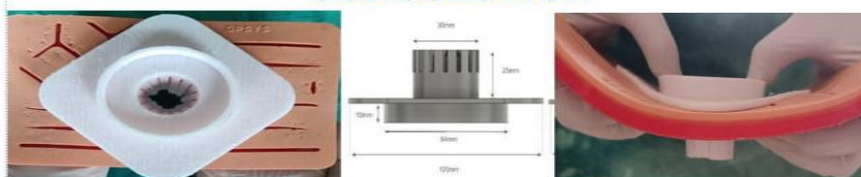


Fig 4: 3D Model and 3D Printed Prototypes of Our Product: StomaSeal (Mucosa-junctional implant)

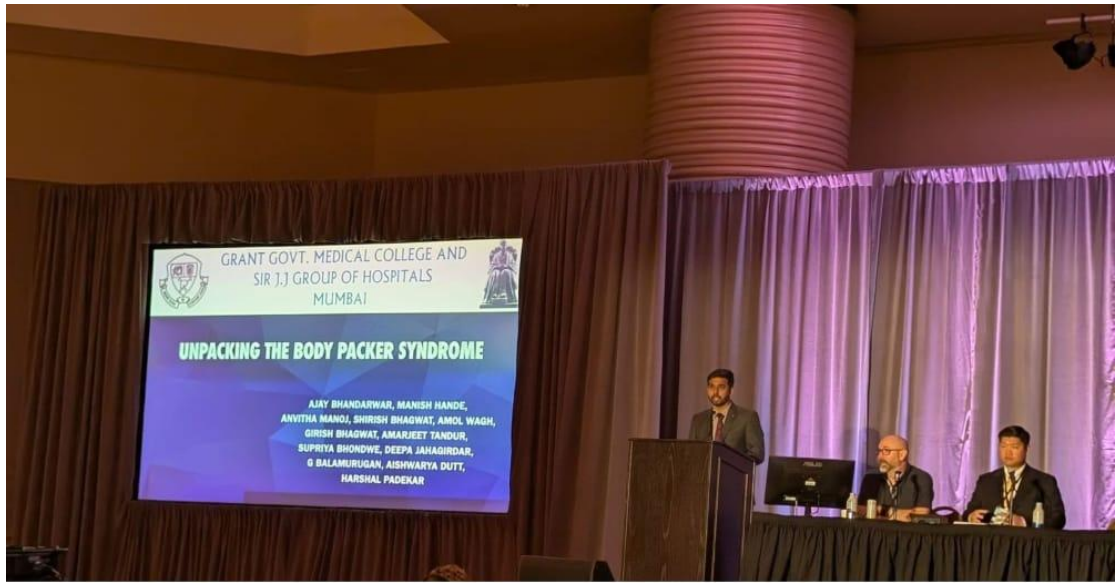
