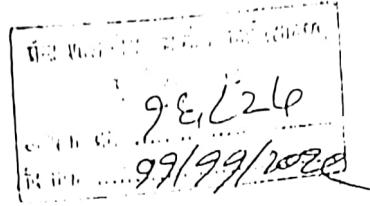

Subject: Increase of seats in MD (Microbiology) course at Grant Medical College, Mumbai, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, Maharashtra u/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for academic year 2020-21 - Permission of Board of Governors - Regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer your proposal for Increase of seats in MD (Microbiology) course at Grant Medical College, Mumbai, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, Maharashtra u/s 10A of the I.M.C Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21.

It is to inform that the Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's report (17th September 2019) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Grant Medical College, Mumbai, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, Maharashtra for Increase of seats in MD (Microbiology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21 and decided as under:

"The Board of Governors considered the Council Assessor's Report (17th September 2019) together with the recommendations of the PG Expert Group (BoG) and decided to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD (Microbiology) course at Grant Medical College, Mumbai, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, Maharashtra u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2020-2021 from 02(Two) to 17(Seventeen) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956."

It is also to inform that the Board of Governors further decided that Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MD (Microbiology) course from 02(Two) to 17(Seventeen) seats as per available facilities, with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2020-21 at Grant Medical College, Mumbai, Maharashtra u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 may be issued.

W In view of the above decision, the Council has decided to obtain undertaking/ essential documents for issue of Letter of Permission for starting/ increase in seats for the academic year 2020-21:

D The applicant should provide all infrastructural facilities in terms of teaching and non-teaching staff, buildings, equipment and hospital facilities as per Medical Council of India norms.

2 No student should be admitted in the above courses till the formal permission of the Board of Governors is granted.
