

The Urban health training center is established in 1962 and it is at 1.5 KM distance from Bandra Railway station (East). UHTC is situated at Bandra Government colony campus near Mahatma Gandhi High School.

CatchmentareaforUHTC

The catchment area compromises the government employees and their families residing in the government colony. There are various types of staff quarter buildings for Class I-IV employees. The colony campus contains three schools, many temples, one community hall, one playground, various shops, banks and Market. The campus also contains a Government Colony Bus Depot.

There are 297 type "B" buildings in government colony. Each B building is four story andhaving 2 quarters on each floor. So there are total around **600 quarters**. 10-12 B buildings forma circular wing, which have a central open place and one main entrance. These B buildings are constructed for Class III employees. There are 7 buildings for class IV employees. These 7 buildings compromise **1244 quarters**.





ONGOINGFIELDPRACTICES ANDRESEARCHPROJECTS

RHTC is involved in ongoing field practices and research projects in and around the RHTC in Palghar. These include community-based cross-sectional studies and assessments on various topics such as the ECCE component of the ICDS program, the prevalence of anxiety disordersamongadolescents, breastfeeding practices, utilization gaps in institutional delivery promoting schemes, and more.
