The following are the Terms and Conditions for submitting the quotation.

1. An amount of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) should be paid by demand draft in the name of "The Dean, Sir J.J.Group of hospitals, Mumbai" with quotation as a security deposit. Quotation submitted without security deposit will not be considered.
2. The amount will be refunded to those, whose rates are not accepted and allotted to them are removed from this institution after making the full payment. If the condemned articles are allotted to the contractor are not remove within the stipulated time the deposit will be forfeited to Government Account.
3. The articles allotted to contractor will have to be removed within the period given to them after making full payment of the articles sold to them. Tender shall remain valid for a period of six months from the date of condemnation order.
4. The quotation should be submitted in sealed cover and the envelope be marked as "QUOTATION FOR CONDEMNED ARTICLES (Scrap Papers, Books & stationery)"
5. Attested Pan card copy and Income Tax return for the year 2023-24 and 2024-25 and GST Registration copy should be submitted alongwith the quotation of the Company.
6. The quotation as mentioned above should be submitted in the office of the Dean, Sir J.J.Group of Hospitals. Mumbai on or before ...27.../...12.../2025.
