

Instructions for NEET Candidates - Department of Psychiatry

Step 1: Document Verification (Head Clerk Office)

Completed Affidavit (Incomplete and Overwritten Affidavits will not be Accepted).

UDID Card & Certificate(Compulsory)(Only Permanent Disability will be accepted).

Previous disability certificate or UDID card (if applicable).

Previous psychological/psychiatric and educational assessment reports.

NEET Admit Card and Score Card.

Aadhaar Card.

Class X and XII mark sheets and certificates.

Step 2: Registration (OPD No. 33)

Generate an OPD Case Paper for Psychiatry OPD no.33

Register the candidate in OPD No. 33

Step 3: Psychiatry Assessment (OPD No. 33)

Candidates will undergo assessment of concerning psychiatric disorder and functional competency by the Psychiatry Department.

Candidates seeking Learning Disability (SLD) verification for NEET will be referred to ENT, Ophthalmology & Neurology.

Late reporting may lead to delays or rescheduling of the assessment.

Step 4: Multidisciplinary Assessment for Candidates with Multiple Disabilities

For candidates requiring multi-specialty opinion, they will be referred to concerned speciality.

Step 5: Certificate Issue by Head Clerk

The disability certificate will be issued on the same day, if processing is completed in time.

If not, it will be provided on the next working day to the candidate at head clerk office

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
